

# **Golf Course Dress Code**

# UNACCEPTABLE

## **ACCEPTABLE**

**Headgear** must be worn correctly – not back to front

## **Shirts**

No T-shirts; football, rugby or similar, and shirts must not be worn outside shorts or trousers.

## **Trousers/Shorts**

No jeans, beach shorts, cargo shorts or denims.

### Socks

No trousers tucked into socks or socks rolled down.



## **Shirts**

Men's shirts must have collars and sleeves and should be worn inside trousers or shorts.

## **Trousers/Shorts**

Full length trousers or kneelength tailored shorts, both without exterior pockets.

#### Socks

Socks must be worn.
Those worn with shorts should be white and plain. Knee length socks may be any colour.

## **S**hoes

No street, canvas, trainers or sandal-type shoes.

#### Shoes

Metal or rubber spiked, moulded or pimple-soled golf shoes must be worn.

Ladies are asked to conform to the essence of the Dress Code (as agreed with the Ladies Committee).
