

DRESS CODE

Members and visitors are required to abide by the code to avoid embarrassment and to aid members of staff who are required to monitor compliance.

GOLFERS

Golf Courses and Practice Areas:

- Gentlemen may wear traditional golf attire designed for the purpose of playing golf. Golf shirts with collar and sleeves, worn inside trousers or shorts.
- Gentlemen may wear full length trousers or knee-length tailored shorts, both without exterior thigh pockets.
- Socks must be worn. Those worn with shorts should be white and plain. Knee length socks maybe any colour and must be co-ordinated.
- Ladies are asked to conform to the essence of the dress code. (As agreed with the Ladies' Committee).
- Golf shoes must be worn on the courses and practice grounds.

TENNIS PLAYERS

Tennis Courts, Outside Terraces and surrounding areas:

- Players may wear any recognised tennis clothing.
- Players must wear recognised tennis shoes, designed for both grass and astro-turf courts.
- Smart tracksuits may be worn for winter play and warm-up in summer months.

MEMBERS AND VISITORS

Terrace Bar, Outside Terraces, Carris Bar and Main Hall.

- Smart casual clothes including approved golf attire.
- Smart denim clothing (not ripped, faded or distressed) is permitted in the Mansion and gardens.
- Tennis players are requested to wear smart tracksuits inside the Mansion. Tennis shoes are permitted.
- Bar purchase from the terrace door is available to players in golf shoes and tennis attire.
- All golf shoes are permitted in the Carris Bar and on the red vinyl strip in the Terrace Bar when entering via the terrace. Only pimple-soled golf shoes may be worn in the carpeted area of the Terrace Bar.

Remaining rooms in the Mansion, including Dining Rooms and Thornhill Room.

- Smart casual wear. Gentlemen are required to wear long trousers, shirts with collar and sleeves or polo-necked sweaters.
- Tracksuits are not permitted.

If any event in the Mansion requires a more (or less) formal style of dress this will be made clear on the notice for the event.

Throughout the Mansion, Practice Grounds, Tennis Courts and Surrounding Terraces.

- Shirts to be worn inside trousers and shorts.
- Hats are not permitted in the Mansion. Outside, peaked hats must be worn with the peak to the front.
- Trainers, rubber, plastic or canvas footwear are not permitted.
- Sports bags, shoe bags, waterproofs, anoraks, golf clubs and tennis rackets must be left in the Locker Rooms and not carried into the Thornhill Room, dining rooms, bars and Main Hall.
- Gentlemen may wear shoes without socks, but not open-toed style footwear.

MOBILE PHONES

- Mobile phones must not be used on the golf courses or tennis courts.
- Telephones may be carried on the courses, switched off, for medical emergency use only.
- Earphones are not permitted when playing golf on the courses – for reasons of health and safety.
- In the Mansion, mobile phones can only be used for calls on the Lower Ground Floor and in private conference rooms.
- Mobile telephones may be used in other rooms of the Mansion for looking up information, texting or emailing, but must be kept on silent mode at all times.
