

## INFORMATION FOR SOCIETY & CORPORATE GOLFERS

### ON THE COURSE

**ETIQUETTE:** Please rake bunkers (replace in the direction of hole), replace divots and repair pitchmarks on the green. Please do not take buggies and trolleys into the deep rough, or in between greenside bunkers and the green.

**DISTANCE MARKERS:** Fairway stones – White 200 yards, Yellow 150 yards, Red 100 yards.

All yardage markers are measured to the centres of the putting green.

**FLAGS:** Red – front / Yellow – middle / Blue – back.

**PACE OF PLAY:** Please keep up with the group in front of you. Rangers will be monitoring pace of play.

**FIRST HOLE:** All players should be on their first hole at least ten minutes before their set tee time.

**HALFWAY HOUSE:** Please take the opportunity to purchase refreshments (cash & card) from our Halfway Houses. High Course Halfway House – after the 8<sup>th</sup> hole. West Course Halfway House – after the 9<sup>th</sup> hole. Please move on from the Halfway House when the group behind approaches. There are Ladies and Gentlemen's facilities at both Halfway Houses.

### PRACTICE FACILITIES

**PRACTICE RANGE:** A short drive or walk from the Mansion. Tokens are available from the Golf Shop. £3.00 for 30 balls / £5.00 for 50 balls. Top Tee – Irons only. Bottom Tee – Irons and Woods.

**PRACTICE NETS:** Practice nets are located behind the 1<sup>st</sup> Tee on the High Course and through the West Car Park.

**PUTTING GREEN:** Located at the back of the Mansion. Putting and Chipping allowed.

### GOLF SHOP

**HIRE ITEMS:** Can be reserved via the Golf Shop (01923 721673). We recommend booking buggies in advance (subject to availability). Buggy use is never guaranteed. Please note that we do not allow buggies during the Winter months and usage is dependent on weather and course/ground conditions.

### GOLF COURSE DRESS CODE

#### UNACCEPTABLE

Headgear *must* be worn correctly – not back to front

#### Shirts

No T-shirts; football, rugby or similar, and shirts must not be worn outside shorts or trousers.

#### Trousers/Shorts

No jeans, beach shorts, cargo shorts or denims.

#### Socks

No trousers tucked into socks or socks rolled down.

#### Shoes

No street, canvas, trainers or sandal-type shoes.



#### ACCEPTABLE

#### Shirts

Men's shirts must have collars and sleeves and should be worn inside trousers or shorts.

#### Trousers/Shorts

Full length trousers or knee-length tailored shorts, both without exterior pockets.

#### Socks

Socks *must* be worn. Those worn with shorts should be white and plain. Knee length socks may be any colour.

#### Shoes

Metal or rubber spiked, moulded or pimple-soled golf shoes must be worn.

### MANSION DRESS CODE

No golf shoes to be worn in the Main Hall please.

No hats to be worn in the Mansion please.

Smart casual is acceptable with smart jeans being permitted.

Towels are provided in the Locker Rooms.

Mobile phones should not be used on the Golf Course or Practice Areas (unless used for scoring purposes or emergency's).
